Overview

CCC (Construction Completion Certificates) and FAC (Final Acceptance Certificates) is a new TAB created within Urban Development Online (UDO) to replace the old standalone application. This tab is used for tracking all the details for infrastructure obligations related to CCC and FAC for each agreement within UDO. This new platform will consolidate internal systems, and provide a more comprehensive and stable experience for both customers and staff.

The details to access the system along with information and how to navigate is as follows:

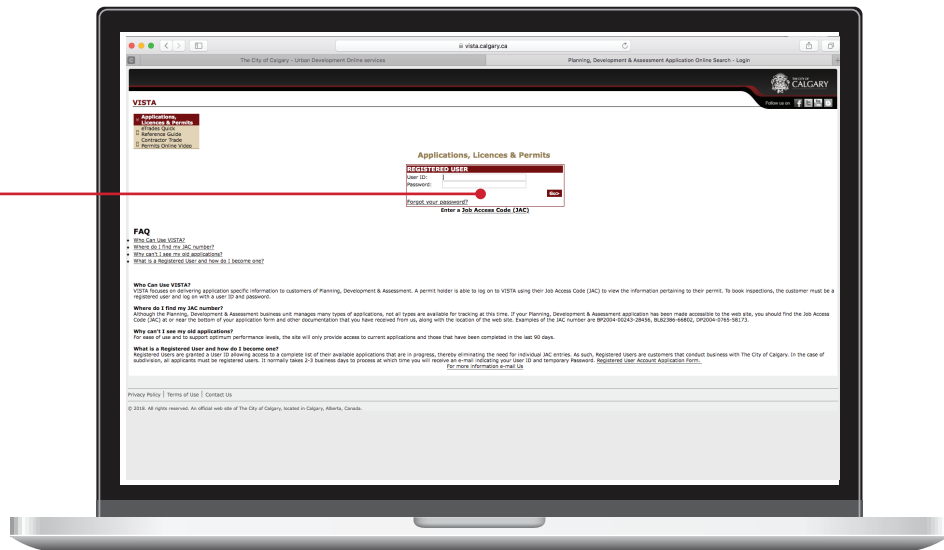
Step 1: Login to VISTA

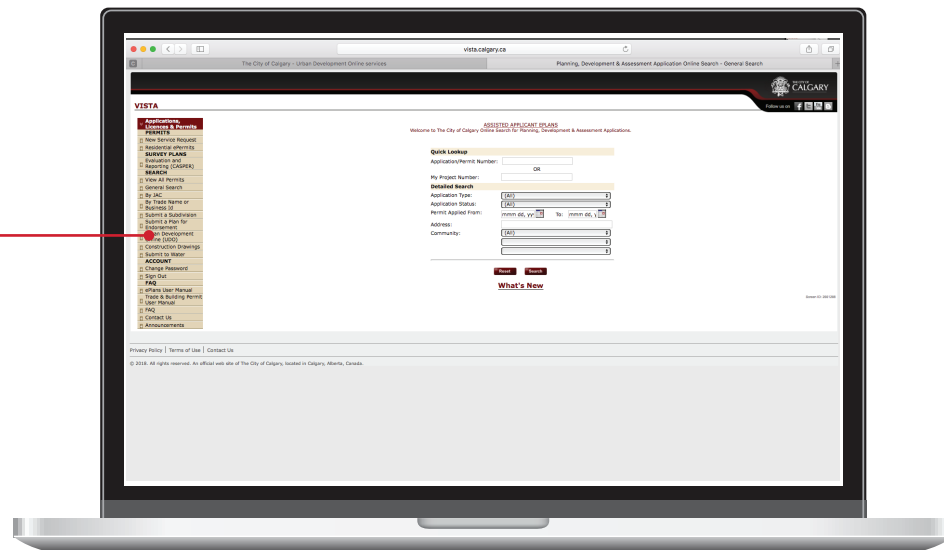

Main CCC-FAC TAB

Section 1

CCC-FAC details

Includes the details of the Certificates as they relate to each infrastructure component.

- What utility for example: sewers, roads, parks
- The description of the component
- Certificate information – to help clarify if required
- Dates received, status and maintenance period

View Notes

Notes that pertain to the infrastructure component

Print summary

Provides a PDF version of the entire CCC/FAC tab

Section 2

Compaction reports

Reports for surface, underground or pond reports.

- Based on specific construction drawings
- Approved by
- Date approved
- Any notes required

Section 3

Add Letter

letters for material compliance or fire hydrant coverage

- CCC/FAC dates
- Any notes required

Section 4

Lots Information

Indicates the number of Undeveloped lots

- Information provided by Roads Inspector

Section 5

Top lift Bond information

Information related to the bond, if a bond is required

Section 6

Block Profile / As-Built Information

Indicates the list construction drawings and their as-built status

Section 7

Notes information

Notes provided by the Public Infrastructure staff
