Section 1: Minimum Application Requirements

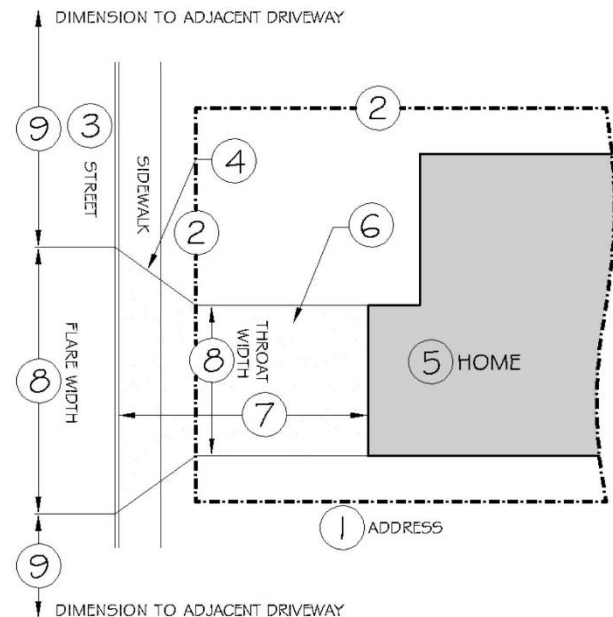
A. Completed [Application Form](#)

B. Completed [Public Tree Disclosure Statement](#)

C. Provide 1 copy of a site plan

Your site plan should include the following:

- 1 Address
- 2 Property lines
- 3 Adjacent Street name
- 4 Existing and Proposed curb cuts including those to be removed and rehabilitated
- 5 Outline of the house and other buildings on the parcel
- 6 Finish material of the driveway
- 7 Dimension length of driveway from garage door to property line
- 8 Dimension width of driveway at throat and flare
- 9 Dimension distance to adjoining driveways



Tip: You can use a real property report as your site plan

Section 2: Additional requirements, only needed if the property has a lane and the new driveway is accessing a street or an existing driveway is being widened.

A. Provide a photograph of existing driveway, if applicable

B. Indicate on your site plan how many parcels on your block currently have a front driveway

Note: Block means all parcels along your side of the street ending at intersections with other streets

Note: The Development Authority may require additional materials considered necessary to properly evaluate the proposed development (as stated in Part 2, Section 26(3) of Land Use Bylaw 1P2007).
